Taggenbrunn Winery revives Carinthia's medieval winemaking tradition, once lost in the 19th century. The first vines were planted in 1997, and since 2011, Andrea and Alfred Riedl have expanded the estate around Taggenbrunn Castle into 40 hectares of south-facing vineyards. Fertile soils, a mild climate and sustainable practices yield wines deeply rooted in nature and history.

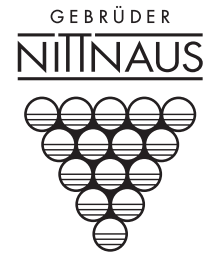
